UNAUDITED INTERIM RESULTS

World Mining Services Limited ("WMS" or "the Company"), the Isle of Man based resource sector technology and service's company is pleased to release its unaudited Interim Results for the period ending 31 March 2010.

DIRECTORS' REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31 MARCH 2010

The first half of the Company's fiscal year reflected the results of the first winter season for Afri- Pal showing minor success in penetrating a market with a traditional mindset. The test marketing with petrol giant PKN Orlen was an overall success, though it highlighted the difficulties inherent in a young company tapping into a broad geographic market at the same time.

Company highlights for the period under review:

- Completed a private placing ("the Placing") with Aureum Investments Limited ("Aureum") which has raised £50,000 at a placing price of 0.6p per share for working capital. Dan Vanrenen, a Director of WMS, is the beneficial owner of Aureum Investments Ltd. For thirty months following 11 March 2010 Aureum also has the option to acquire an additional 8,333,333 shares at 0.6p.
- Accepted the resignation of Director, Jonathan Harrison
- Relocation of Afri-Pal factory

Afri- Pal

The Company has actively supported Afri-Pal to enter new markets and gain new clients and is diligently working to evolve the business model to include a broader range of services that will be less subject to seasonal fluctuations. In January, the Company signed a Joint Venture Agreement with P.P.U.H Elmo s.c. ("Elmo") to convert coal slimes into fuel pellets at the Janina 2 mine site in Poland. Afri-Pal has also relocated its factory to the Janina 2 site. The Janina 2 mine site is owned by Kompania Węglowa S. A. ("Kompania Węglowa") and is situated in Libiaz, Poland. The mine site closed approximately ten years ago.

In February, the Company increased its equity ownership in Afri-Pal from 78% to 84.6%. This is a result of WMS agreeing to reduce the outstanding loan from WMS to Afri-Pal by £65,430 in exchange for 3,000 shares in Afri-Pa. Under the terms of the agreement, Afri-Pal has the right to repurchase the 3,000 shares from WMS at a price of 120 Zloty [£26.5] per share on or before 11 December 2012.

Minex

In November Minex provided the Company with encouraging results from the continuous test showing that the process extracted a very high percentage of the available metals- well over 80% in most cases. The material input, which was from a Southern African lead smelter, has high levels of zinc with lesser levels of lead, copper and rare metals. 85% of the zinc and 90% of the lead was extracted and recovered. The cost of the extraction and recovery of the metals represented about 50% of the value of the metals extracted versus today's metals market value. The process itself generates a great deal of heat. Minex has found that with many of the materials under review, once primed, the extraction process generates most of the energy it requires for the operation. The heat waste could be used to generate power. During the process, it was identified that there were some shortcomings in the

construction of the pilot plant that lead to excessive wear of the plant even though it was mostly formed of toughened steel.

Subsequent to these tests, it was discovered that the recovery levels, during the continuous run, had in fact been much higher than originally identified. This means that the new recovery plant requires about 80% less energy and the cost of the process has dropped considerably. The Company remains a passive investor of 11,600 shares.

True North

True North remained dormant during the period under review.
